### ***Technological Enhancements***

- Safari/Montage Phase 2: “Offers broadcast quality, video-on-demand from the finest educational publishers in the world...includes a powerful search engine to help educators create dynamic and engaging lessons.”

Safari Montage allows digital media access on demand in every curricular area and can provide up to 6 cable television channels for broadcast of live or archived student-created news, student conventions, sports events, theater, student-created film/videos and other presentations.

- Mac Lab: Upgrading this lab for our students will ensure that they are not working on antiquated machines, but rather are working at industry standards. The lab is a vital resource for our students to meet the Visual and Performing Arts requirement as well as showcase their talents for the community, Advanced Placement, universities, and career internships or employment.

### ***Gateway and Mentoring***
