

Out-of-Season Sports and Facility Use (CIF Rule 600.2)

This applies to all Torrey Pines athletic programs that are club or CIF sports. For more information, please read the [CIF Liability and Rules Advisory](#) document

Torrey Pines athletic teams may not compete or have preseason practices as a school team when the sport is out-of-season. An outside team may be formed under these guidelines:

- The team must be part of an outside entity (i.e. AAU, Boys & Girls Club, etc).
- The team cannot use school equipment **unless it has written approval from the school/district.**
- The team cannot use school funds or school transportation.
- Coaches cannot require students to participate as a condition for membership of the school team during the season.

Out-of-season teams can have camps, clinics and preseason injury prevention workouts in the off season that are run through the TPHSF (Foundation). Facilities can be used in two ways:

- 1) If the camp, clinic, or club is a team fundraiser (CCT), the fundraiser will be cleared first through the Foundation. Once approved, the facilities will be reserved through the athletic secretary (tathletics@sduhsd.net). In addition, the following conditions must be met:
 - Liability insurance must be obtained through the foundation.
 - Every athlete must be a member of an outside entity (i.e. AAU, Boys & Girls Club, etc).
 - The program must be registered with an outside entity.
 - Every must athlete, or minor, must have a parent sign a waiver of consent and fill out health insurance information
 - The name of the camp, club and/or clinic **cannot** include the school name "Torrey Pines".
 - The TP Falconhead **can** be used.
 - Information cannot be posted or advertised on the school athletic website, sport specific team websites, nor team social media accounts associated with Torrey Pines. Information can only be posted on the Foundation website. You can create a link from the team website and call it an "Optional Clinic" (include a more detailed description). An example would be a link from the team website to an "Optional Fall Clinic" and that would take you to the Foundation website where the information can be posted.
 - Torrey Pines sports specific clothing that says "Torrey Pines or TP" **cannot** be worn at athletic competitions by athletes or coaches.

- 2) If the camp, clinic or club is **not** a school fundraiser, lease of the facilities will go through Zephyr Fletcher at the TPHS Foundation, zephyr.fletcher@sduhsd.net. *Same rules as above still apply.*
 - Liability insurance must be obtained through the foundation.
 - Every athlete must be a member of an outside entity (i.e. AAU, Boys & Girls Club, etc).
 - The program must be registered with an outside entity.
 - The name of the camp, club and/or clinic **cannot** include the school name "Torrey Pines".
 - The TP Falconhead **can** be used.
 - Information cannot be posted or advertised on the school athletic website, sport specific team websites, nor team social media accounts associated with Torrey Pines. Information can only be posted on the Foundation website. You can create a link from the team website and call it an "Optional Clinic" (include a more detailed description). An example would be a link from the team website to an "Optional Fall Clinic" or "Preseason Strength & Conditioning" and that would take you to the Foundation website where the information can be posted.
 - Torrey Pines sports specific clothing that says "Torrey Pines or TP" **cannot** be worn at athletic competitions by athletes or coaches.

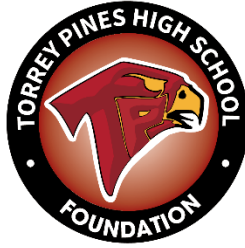
